- + Technical accuracy and completeness of the Design Documents at all stages of development
- + Appropriate application and incorporation of building, zoning, energy, accessibility, and other relevant codes to all projects
- + Appropriate application and incorporation of recent and relevant building science and materials to all projects
- + Manage, coordinate, and serve as the primary point of contact of consultants, building agencies, and contractors
- + Generate and pick up redlines

Qualifications

- + years of experience or demonstrated equivalence
- + Has a bachelor's degree in architecture, interior design, or related degree from an accredited program
- + Exercises independent judgment in evaluation, selection, and use of standard techniques, solves typical and conventional problems when encountered, and receives guidance on unusual or complex design problems
- + Independently develops and documents project technical strategies, collateral, and deliverables under the supervision of more experienced staff
- + Proficient in Revit, AutoCAD, Photoshop, 3D modeling, rendering, SketchUp, Adobe Creative Suite, Microsoft Office and purchasing software
- + Demonstrates familiarity with and understanding of contract terms and provisions, and is able to identify items outside of scope or add on services
