The Astor Library with cerused oak paneling and stone surround fireplace has been completed and will be a space to gather for cocktails and private intimate events. The Grand Stair features custom steel railing and antique mirrored walls with intricate wood paneling. Olives Restaurant is expected to open at the end of November with a new bar and the adjoining Aspen Room containing a custom wine wall.
